If so then read on as your family are eligible to have a short break at the new purpose built accommodation located in Plas Newydd, Anglesey, North Wales

Young people were asked to choose a name for the building and “Mountain View Lodge” or “Gyflwyno barn Mynydd” was selected. An event is planned in May and the accommodation will be available to families living within Cheshire West and Chester or attending school in the area.

The single storey residential building will provide accommodation for families with disabled children to enjoy short breaks, catering for a wide range of disabilities. The facilities will include:

- Vehicle access/drop-off point at entrance
- Level access via terrace
- Four bedrooms including 2 specialist en-suite bedrooms
- Accessible shower and bathrooms
- Spacious Living / Dining space
- Accessible kitchen
- Utility room
- Store
- Fixtures/fittings/components/finishes designed for access by all

The building has been designed to have an overall welcoming and homely feel that can accommodate children (aged 0-19) of very different disabilities inclusively. The main living / dining space is open plan and spacious to provide ease of use by wheelchair users with direct access to the outdoor terrace. The fully accessible kitchen is open to the dining area to maintain the feeling of inclusiveness.
